The PRINCE2 2017 Update represents the first major revision of PRINCE2 since 2009. The updated guidance, *Managing Successful Projects with PRINCE2*, and new Foundation and Practitioner examinations form the PRINCE2 2017 update.

The method is widely recognized and understood and so provides a common vocabulary for all those involved in a project, which helps effective communication. The method also provides for the explicit recognition of project responsibilities so that participants understand each other's roles and needs. There is a defined structure for accountability, delegation, authority and communication.

PRINCE2 Practitioner Exam Format:

- Objective testing
- Eight questions - 10 question items per question, each worth one mark
- 44 marks or more required to pass (out of 80 available) - 55%
- Two-and-a-half hours
- (150 minutes) duration, no additional reading time
- Open book exam (official PRINCE2 manual only)
